

Connect to the SU-Guest Network

The SU-Guest Wi-Fi network is for visitors during large events or gatherings on campus

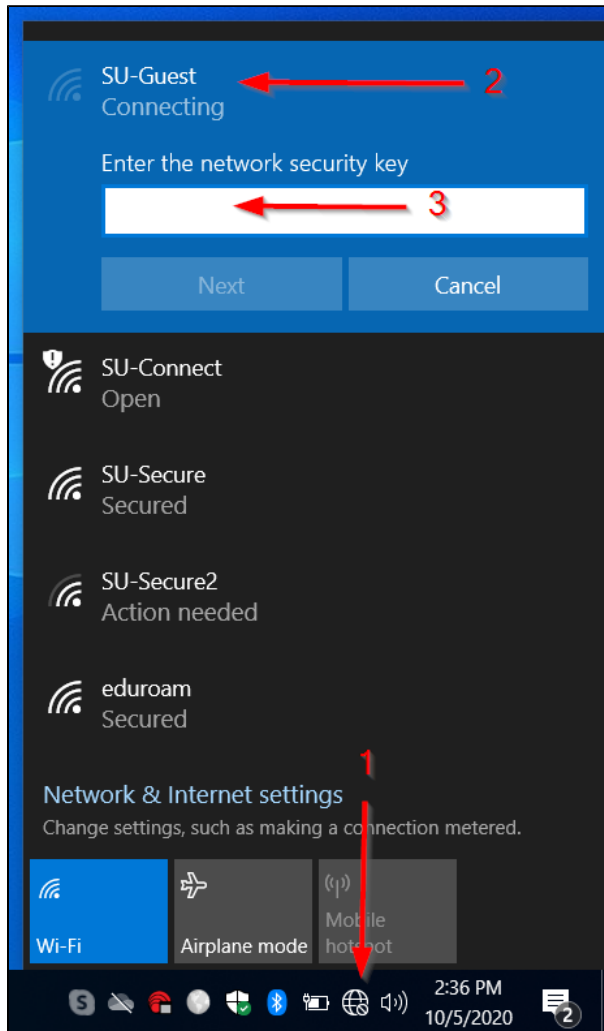
The Guest password is available to guest during an event only by calling our IT Help Desk at 410-677-5454. Students, faculty, and staff should connect to SU-Secure using their username and password. See [Internet Access](#) for instructions on connecting to SU-Secure.

This document will give general instructions on how to connect to the SU-Guest wifi network. Instructions will vary depending on your device.

1. Go to your **Wifi** settings/options
2. Choose **SU-Guest** from the list of available networks
3. **Enter the password** for the SU-Guest network

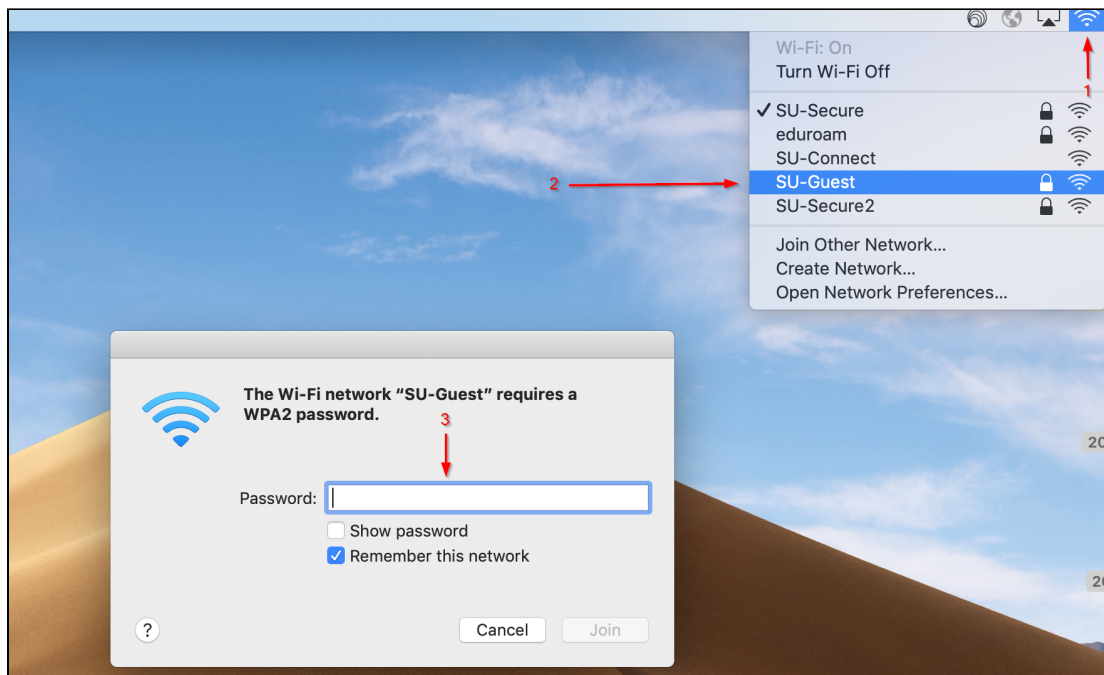
For **Windows**:

Select the Wi-Fi icon located in bottom right corner. Choose Su-Guest from the list of available networks and enter the password when prompted.



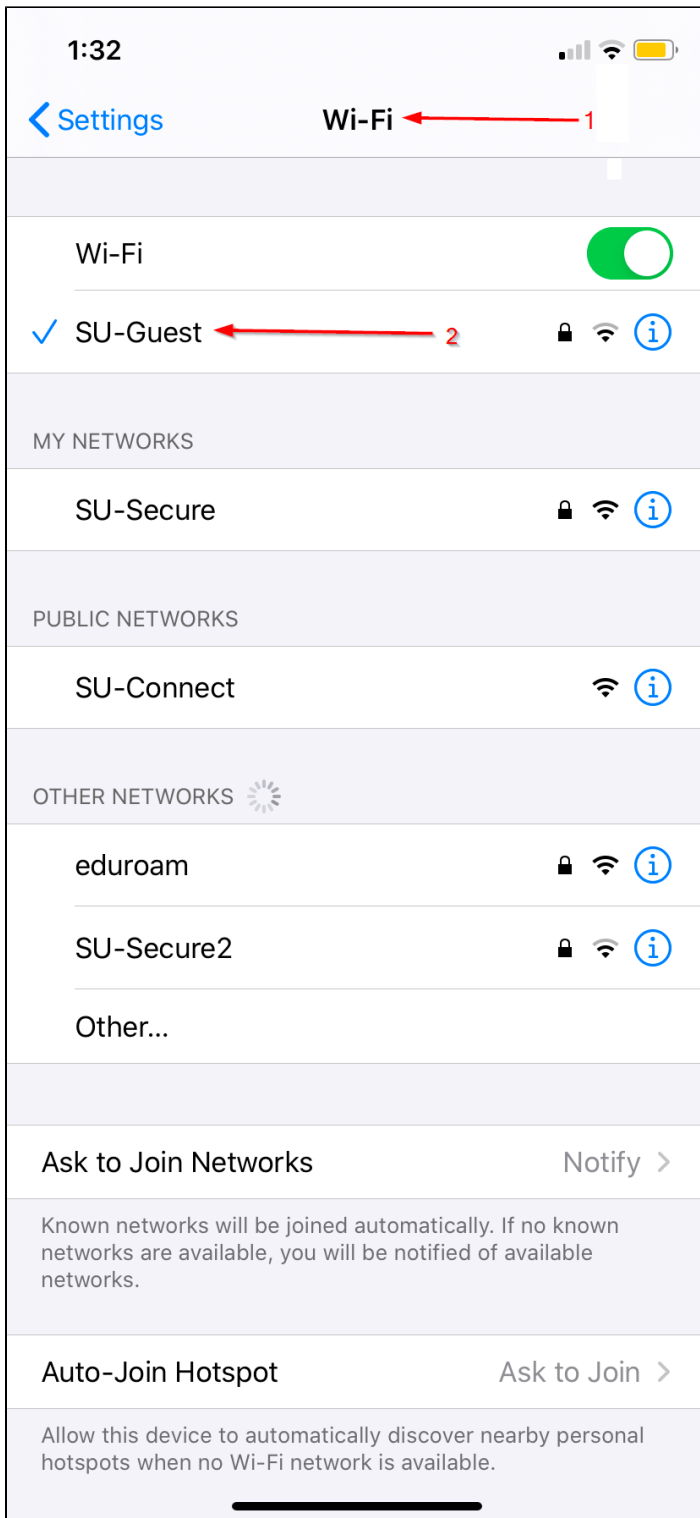
For **Mac OS**:

Select the Wi-Fi icon at the top right corner of the screen. Choose Su-Guest from the list of available networks and enter the password when prompted.



For iPhones:

Go to Settings/Wi-Fi and choose Su-Guest from the list of available networks. Enter the password when prompted.



For **Androids**:

Swipe down and select the Wi-Fi icon. Choose SU-Guest from the list of networks and enter the password when prompted.
